

## KidSport's Hockey Assist Program (HAP) Season 3 Policy, 2024-2025

## **FUNDING DETAILS**

- How to Apply
  - o Use the application located on KidSport Edmonton's (KSE) website by clicking here
- Season 3 Timeline
  - o HAP Season 3 runs from May 1, 2024, to April 30, 2025
- HAP Funding Rules
  - o Maximum funding amount for all chapters will be capped at \$750 per child.
  - o All approved kids receive access to no-cost sport equipment through Sport Central
  - o A kid is only eligible for HAP funding once per HAP season (i.e., spring or summer)
  - A kid funded through HAP can receive funding for other sports through KidSport's 'So ALL Kids Can Play!' Grant Program (i.e., hockey + swimming)

- Programs NOT funded by HAP, but funded by KSE
  - Unsanctioned Hockey
    - Teams that are part of the following leagues: Hockey Super League (HSL), Junior Prospects Hockey League (JPHL), Premier Hockey League (PHL), Canadian American Junior Hockey League (CAJHL)
  - Academies
    - School academy programs (i.e., Vimy Ridge, Edge, OHA)
  - Skill Development & Non-Ice Hockey Programs
    - Ringette
    - Ball hockey
    - Roller hockey
    - Figure Skating
    - General Learn to Skate/Learn to Figure Skate Programs
    - Hockey based camps
    - Power Skating
    - Skill Development Programs
    - Try It Programs
